

THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY FOR WESTERN CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

JULY 21, 1995

- WHEREAS, The construction and subsequent opening of the O'Neill Center on the Westside Campus of Western Connecticut State University has greatly increased the traffic at the site, particularly for special events, and
- WHEREAS, The multipurpose use of the O'Neill Center allows for events that will draw significant numbers of people from both the University and public communities, and
- WHEREAS, The future construction of a new 425 bed residence hall will increase the activity at the site and increase the number of parking spaces and vehicles by approximately 282, and
- WHEREAS, The initial evaluation of the master planning update currently underway for Western Connecticut State University has resulted in a recommendation to provide a second access to and egress from the site, and
- WHEREAS, The legislature authorized \$1,000,000 for Connecticut State University for property acquisition in the 1995 Capital Budget, and
- WHEREAS, Property may be available that would link the Westside Campus to Westville Avenue, a road that would be an appropriate secondary access and egress route, therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Board authorize the continued investigation, negotiation and purchase of land for the development of secondary access/egress road for Western Connecticut State University
