CSCU Student Success Key Performance Indicators:

2021 Community Colleges Report'

This is the fifth annual CSCU report on Student Success Key Performance Indicators (KPI) containing leading indicators of student success for First Time Ever in College (FTEIC) students. It has been updated to include fall 2021 students (n = 7,416), expanding the data set to nine (9) years.

All 7,416 students who attended in fall having never previously attended a higher education institution are included in this data set. This includes full-time and part-time students.

This report is disseminated annually to faculty, staff, and administrators of all CSCU community colleges as directed by the CSCU Board of Regents. The report is presented jointly by CSCU Success and the CSCU Office of Decision Support and Institutional Research (formerly the Office of Research and System Effectiveness or ORSE).



CSCU BOR & Guided Pathways

In their 2018 resolution (BR-089), the CSCU Board of Regents (BOR) committed the CSCU system to implementing the Guided Pathways framework to improve and increase student enrollment, retention, and completion for Connecticut State Community College (CT State).

To support their resolution, the CSCU BOR adopted five (5) transformational Guided Pathways policies. The suite of Guided Pathways policies are:


Why Key Performance Indicators (KPIs)?

Community colleges are measured by long-term indicators such as three-year completion rates. However, when we focus solely on these long-term measures, it is difficult to determine whether our educational innovations are effective in the near term.

Short-term measures, such as semester-to-semester persistence, provide timely feedback but do not always correlate with long-term completion rates. Therefore, this report focuses on short-term student success KPIs demonstrated nationally to correlate with completion. These data, which are available quickly and help predict eventual success, are known as leading indicators.

CSCU BORs' Guided Pathways policies were carefully and intentionally designed to support CT State's work to improve and increase student success and equity. When implemented simultaneously and at scale, similar asset-based reforms implemented by peer institutions across the country have demonstrated to be a powerful tool for advancing equitable student success.

Per the Guided Pathways policies adopted by the BOR, CT State will complete implementation no later than 2025. As we approach the release of the 2025 KPI report, CSCU will look to the KPIs to illustrate and celebrate advancements in closing institutional performance gaps.
