CCRC is very interested in following the CT State GPA model.

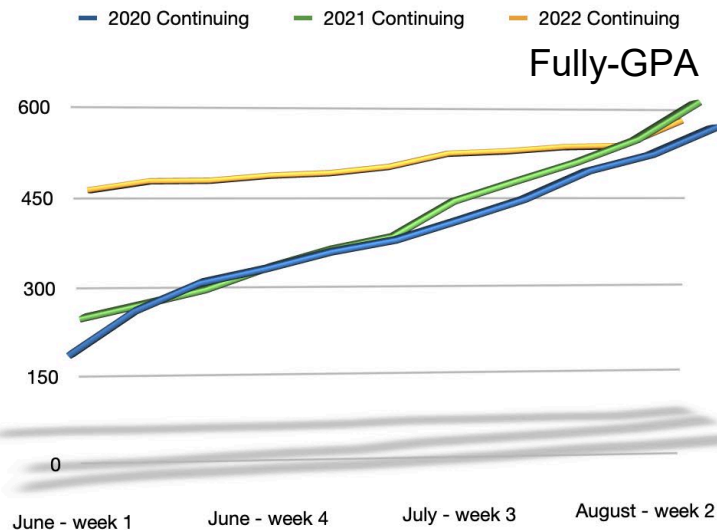
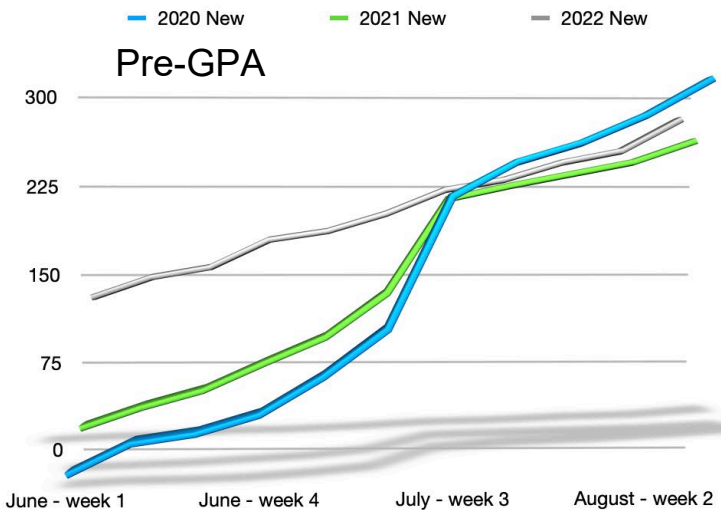


Guided Pathways Advising: Impact on Retention & Registration

- Our Fall-Spring Retention increased 8% overall,
- **Hispanic Student Retention (16% overall enrollment) increased 15%, and**
- Students have an academic plan much sooner and **register much earlier – an early indicator of student success.**
- Clearly makes **class schedule planning** much easier!
