



Credit Attainment and Remediation: Results from P20WIN for the Graduation Cohort of 2011

During the summer of 2014, three Connecticut state agencies—the Connecticut State Department of Education, the Board of Regents for Higher Education, and the Department of Labor—successfully completed a pilot project and established the Preschool through 20 and Workforce Information Network. In 2015, the University of Connecticut (UConn) joined the effort, adding significantly to the scope of the data and analysis. P20WIN is an unprecedented interagency network that securely links data to gain new insights that can help improve the policies and procedures that affect individuals and students these agencies serve. The results contained herein are from a query of P20WIN data that provides an evaluation of the postsecondary outcomes achieved by the high school graduation cohort of 2011 in Connecticut’s public universities and community colleges.

Table 1: Statewide Results by Subgroup

Of the more than 37,000 on-time graduates in the 2011 graduation cohort (i.e., first-time freshmen in the fall of 2007), 45.4 percent enrolled in a Connecticut Public University or Community College within 16 months of their high school graduation. Of the students enrolled in Connecticut public universities and community colleges, 59.9 percent earned a year’s worth of college credit (24 credits) within two years of enrollment. Female students were slightly more likely than male students to have enrolled and earned a year’s credit in that time (61.6 percent as compared with 58.1 percent).

While black and Hispanic students were more likely to enroll in Connecticut public universities and community colleges than their white or Asian student peers, they earned credits at a significantly lower rate (45.8 and 48.9 percent, respectively) than white (64.6 percent) or Asian (72.6 percent) students. Fifty-three percent of English Learners and 40.4 percent of students with disabilities earned a year’s credit in two years, significantly lower than overall rate of 59.9 percent. While students eligible for free or reduced price meals were more likely to attend Connecticut public universities and community colleges than those not eligible for free or reduced price meals, they too earned college credit at significantly lower rates (48.0 percent) than students who were ineligible (65.9 percent).

The enrollment and credit-earning data included UConn, all Connecticut community colleges, and the four Connecticut state universities. However, UConn does not collect data on remediation, and is thus not included in the numerator or denominator in the remediation statistics. Overall, 46.4 percent of the students from the 2011 graduating cohort who enrolled in Connecticut community colleges or the four Connecticut state universities participated in at least one remediation course. Male students were less

likely to have been enrolled in remedial coursework than female students (44.3 percent as compared with 48.2 percent). Black and Hispanic students were enrolled in remedial coursework at a significantly higher rate (64.4 and 64.7 percent respectively) than white (37.5 percent) or Asian (44.9 percent) students. Over 70 percent of English learners enrolled in some remedial coursework. High rates of participation in remedial coursework were also evidenced among students with disabilities (71.5 percent) and students eligible for free or reduced price meals (62.5 percent).

The percent of students from the 2011 graduation cohort who participated in at least one remediation course (46.4 percent) was lower than that of the 2010 graduation cohort (48 percent). The remediation rate for the 2011 graduation cohort was lower for almost all student subgroups including males, females, black students, Hispanic students, white students, English learners, students with disabilities, and students eligible for free or reduced price meals.

Tables 2 and 3: Results by District and School

Tables 2 and 3 provide enrollment, credit earning, and remediation by district and high school respectively. Although students may have changed schools or districts during their high school career, their results are attributed to the high school from which they graduated. The results show significant variation in all the measures.

The district-level data show that the rate of enrollment in Connecticut public universities and community colleges ranged from 10.2 in Darien to 69.7 percent in Bethel. Credit-earning rates at Connecticut public universities and community colleges exhibited considerable variation, ranging from 37.0 percent in New Haven to 83.8 percent in East Haddam. Half of districts had credit-earning rates above 64.9 percent. Additionally, remediation rates varied quite significantly across districts as well, ranging from a low of 10.4 percent in Bethel to 71.2 percent in Bloomfield. Fifty percent of schools had more than a 40.6 percent remediation rate.

The school-level data show that the rate of enrollment at Connecticut public universities and community colleges ranged from 10.2 percent to over 95 percent across high schools. Credit-earning rates at Connecticut public universities and community colleges also exhibited considerable variation among high schools, ranging from less than 5 percent to 83.7 percent. Remediation rates varied quite significantly across schools as well, ranging from a low of 10.2 percent to a high of greater than 95 percent. Fifty percent of schools had more than a 45.4 percent remediation rate.
